#### HOW MUCH DOES IT COST?



"Consistent and Unpredictable!" Psalm 145:3 says, "Great is the Lord and greatly to be praised; his greatness is unsearchable." There's a lot that we can know about God: His basic character, His nature, His covenants, His commitment to people, His sense of holiness and justice and love. Read His Word long enough, and you can get to know the God we worship. But as knowable as God is—the text says His greatness is unsearchable—there's a limit to what the finite mind can comprehend about the infinite God.
