Community Groups run for 10 weeks. Your group will participate in group discussion, following the guide of the study material. You will experience encouragement and prayer from the support of your group members.

Apart from just coming together for your group sessions, Community Groups plan and prepare community service projects. Our emphasis this session will be in serving at one of our Soul Soup nights hosted at TLR. These take place the last 2 Tuesdays of each month.

Connect With God, Community, & your purpose!

The Rooted experience redefines how people live life and view their relationship with God and others, giving context to what it means to be part of something bigger. You will begin to see God in new ways, allowing you to experience a different way of life: community, authenticity and generosity.

Genesis Process

The Genesis Process provides a Biblical and neurochemical understanding of what is broken and causes our coping skills.

If we don't first understand what is broken, how can we devise a recovery plan that really works? We believe the best evangelism is a changed life. Therefore it is the goal of The Genesis Process and Programs to be intimately involved as part of the body of Christ in the Great Commission through the successful restoration of broken lives.

The Bible and other literature have told us for literally thousands of years that if we want to change who we are and what we do, we have to change our heart. New understanding from brain research shows us how trauma (abuse and neglect) can distort who we are and what we believe and thus how we act. Genesis is intentional about initiating lasting heart (brain) changes, thus bringing healing to what drives destructive behavior rather than just coping with it.

The Genesis Process includes 20 sessions to work through. The cost is \$40 for the group which includes the workbook and the celebration dinner.

It may be hard for you to feel optimistic about the future right now. If you've lost a spouse, child, family member, or friend, you've probably found there are not many people who understand the deep hurt you feel. This can be a confusing time when you feel isolated and have many questions about things you've never faced before.

GriefShare groups meet weekly for 13 weeks to help you face these challenges and move toward rebuilding your life. You will experience video seminars featuring top experts on grief and recovery. After viewing the video, you and the other group members will spend time as a support group, discussing what was presented in that week's video seminar and what is going on in your lives. During the week you will have the opportunity to use your workbook for further personal study of the grieving process, and to help sort out your emotions through journaling.

Cost for GriefShare is \$25 for the workbook.
